A public hearing shall occur on this ordinance at the Chesterfield Township Municipal Building, 300 Bordentown-Chesterfield Road in Chesterfield Township at 7:30 PM on March 25, 2010 at which time the Township Committee may take formal action to adopt the ordinance.
