

**TOWNSHIP OF CHESTERFIELD
ORDINANCE 2010-22**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 182-26 OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF CHESTERFIELD ENTITLED, "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL
TIMES" TO REMOVE CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS ON FENTON LANE**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 2009-7, the Township Committee established certain "parking prohibited at all times" restrictions on both sides of Fenton Lane for a specific portion of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, since the enactment of said Ordinance, the Township Engineer has reevaluated the parking restrictions on the eastern side of Fenton Lane and has recommended that same can be reduced along the "straight portions of the road", to wit: along the eastern side, the parking restrictions shall remain for the properties of 35 Fenton Lane to 23 Fenton Lane, but same can be lifted from 37 Fenton Lane to Chilton Drive, and from 21 Fenton Lane to Bordentown-Crosswicks Road; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(b)(1)(a) acknowledges that a municipality is given the ability to designate parking restrictions on streets which are self-contained within the Township, provided that the adopted Resolution or Ordinance is transmitted to the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation for validation, and the Township Engineer has recommended the adoption of these revisions to the no parking zone along Fenton Lane;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

ARTICLE I. AMENDED SECTION.

Section 182-6 entitled, "Section V II: Parking Prohibited at all Times", is hereby amended, and Ordinance 2009-7 is also hereby amended, to change the parking restrictions along Fenton Lane by deleting the former text and now inserting the following:

NAME OF STREET	SIDE	LOCATION
Fenton Lane	both	Beginning at Block 201, Lot 13.03 (26 Fenton Lane) and Extending northerly to the end Of Lot 11 (12 Fenton Lane); except, however, that on the eastern side of the roadway, the parking restrictions can be lifted from that stretch beginning with 37 Fenton Lane to Chilton Drive, and from 21 Fenton Lane to Bordentown-Crosswicks Road

ARTICLE II. REFERRAL TO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

This Ordinance shall be forwarded to the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of *N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(b)(1)(a)*.

ARTICLE III. REPEALER, SEVERABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

- A. Repealer. Any and all Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
- B. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the Township Committee hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that it allows he Township to meet the goals of the Ordinance.
- C. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.
